



„CORONA Sicherheits- und Präventionskonzept“  
für den 18. Europäischen Verkehrskongress /  
17. Baltisches Verkehrsforum  
Montag, 12.10. bis Mittwoch, 14.10.2020

## Preamble

This Corona security and prevention concept aims to keep the risk of infection for the organizers and participants of the events as low as possible. According to the current state ordinance, events with up to 200 people in closed rooms are generally permitted in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania. The ETC never reaches this number. The following information and guidelines are binding for all participants, helpers and organizers. By actively participating in the congress, the participants acknowledge these regulations and guarantee that they will be followed. The DVWG and EPTS work closely with the event partners. These partners have their own hygiene concepts, which we offer for download on the website [www.dvwg-mv.de](http://www.dvwg-mv.de). Depending on the part of the event, the participants have to inform themselves, to accept these rules and to behave accordingly. Our event partners are:

## These hygiene measures are generally required:

- Regularly wash hands with soap or disinfect with disinfectant. Sufficient disinfectant dispensers are available.
- Compliance with the distance rule of 1.5 m
- Do not touch the face and especially the mouth, eyes and nose with your fingers
- Avoid shaking hands and hugs
- Sneezing and coughing in the crook of your arm or in a paper tissue, which must be disposed of

## General rules for attending the event

- Attending the events is at your own risk. The 18th ETC may only be attended if you are completely free from relevant COVID-19 symptoms. Participants with symptoms will be refused entry.
- The COVID-19 risk group as defined by the Ministry of Health is recommended not to attend the event.
- We intend to measure the body temperature of all participants to ensure that only fever-free participants join the conference and its side-events.
- Only the registered people are allowed to enter the events. A photo ID is to be carried. We ask all participants to install and activate the Corona Warn app of the Robert Koch Institute on their smartphone.



- In the course of registration, address data, email and telephone number of the participants are collected in order to forward them to the health department if necessary. The data will be deleted four weeks after the event.

## Rules during the event participation

- **DISTANCE:** Maintain a distance of at least 1.5 m between yourself and all other people.
- **ENTRY MANAGEMENT:** Do not form a tight queue at the registration. When entering, mouth and nose protection is mandatory and the distance rules must be observed. Please be there early to reduce queuing and support the start of the conference in time. Information signs, labels and floor markings indicate this accordingly. Participants receive a conference bag with various pre-picked documents in order to keep the duration of the registration as short as possible. Participants also receive a name badge that they can attach themselves.
- **CLOAKROOM:** The cloakroom in the Kurhaus is right next to the entrance. It is an unguarded self-service cloakroom. Please also pay attention to the distance here. Use the cloakroom before you register.
- **SEATING:** There is only seating. Please use your seat during the entire event, unless you switch between the Kurhaus and the Hotel Neptun. The mouth and nose protection can be removed at the seat.
- **PHOTOGRAPHY:** Taking photos during the event is permitted from your seat. The photographer officially commissioned by the organizer is exempt from this rule.
- **YOUR OWN RESPONSIBILITY:** If you feel unwell or ill or notice symptoms, please stay at home or, in the worst case, leave the event immediately and inform us afterwards.
- **WEAR MOUTH AND NOSE PROTECTION:** In general, mouth and nose protection should always be worn. This is only not the case if you are sitting at your seat or consuming food and drink.

## **Special rules for single events of the side-program:**

### *Welcome reception*

The passenger ship "Rostocker 7" has two decks. Participants are required to wear mouth and nose protection on board, especially when talking in small groups. The mouth and nose protection can be removed when eating or drinking. The food is served in buffet form on the lower deck, drinks are available on the upper deck. Avoid the jostling at the buffet. The toilets can only be used individually. The number of participants is limited, so that a distance of 1.5m can be maintained at all times.

### *Gala-Evening*

During the gala evening, the mouth and nose protection must be worn any time. The sole exemptions are while seated or consuming food and drinks. Drinks are served at the table by the service staff. Meals are served in buffet form. Dancing is forbidden.

### *Technical Excursions*

During transfers by bus to the excursion destinations - as is currently common practice in public transport - you should wear face and mouth protection. When entering the bus, the hands must be disinfected, appropriate dispensers are available. During the stay in closed rooms (on board the "Copenhagen", in the rooms of Rostock-Port, in the bodyshop of the "Molli" as well as in the MSCW, mouth and nose protection must be worn. On deck of the "Copenhagen" or if the distance rule is adhered to, this is not necessary in the open air area. We have limited the number of participants in order to avoid the need for stricter safety precautions.
